The Harry Denman Evangelism Award

Recognizing clergy and lay persons for outstanding service in evangelism

The Harry Denman Evangelism Awards honor a United Methodist lay and clergy person in each annual conference who has exhibited unusual and outstanding efforts in Christian evangelism by faithfully carrying out the mission of "making disciples of Jesus Christ."

Those eligible for this prestigious award are persons who are practicing the Great Commission. This can involve personal witnessing, speaking, and inspiring individual persons or the local church to be actively involved helping people to experience the transforming love of God through Jesus Christ. Neither the size of the local church with which the person is affiliated, the age or gender of the person, nor the length of their service should limit one's eligibility. What is important are the persons whose lives have been changed by the life and ministry of the nominee.

Each annual conference is encouraged to honor one lay person and one clergy person each year and to present the awards at their

annual conference. Nominations are to be sent to the conference office.

The information on selected recipients is sent to The Foundation for Evangelism at least four weeks prior to the presentation date. This information should include the proper name, address and telephone number of the recipient, along with some biographical information and a brief statement affirming the selection. Include the date the award is to be presented with this information.

The Foundation for Evangelism will provide, without cost to the annual conference, a beautiful certificate in an attractive binder for each person who is honored. Recipients will later receive a letter of congratulations from The Foundation for Evangelism, along with a copy of *Harry Denman: A Biography* by Harold Rogers.
