One such change is that Dr. Jack Ewing was called to be the executive director for the Lake Junaluska Conference and Retreat Center. The board of trustees has named Jane Boatwright Wood as interim executive director while conducting a national search. Mrs. Wood has worked with the Foundation in various capacities over the last six years, most recently as vice president, and she is active in local church lay leadership at First United Methodist Church, Waynesville, N.C.

We continued to expand our Excellence Recognition programs with two new awards – the Harry Denman Youth Evangelism Award and the Culture of the Call Church Award – celebrating individuals and local churches that excel in the area of Wesleyan evangelism in the 21st century. The Foundation for Evangelism is now, perhaps more than ever, living its vision to raise up generations of leaders with a passion for evangelism who will have a multiplying impact on The United Methodist Church.

Refresh Campus Ministry Gathering

Funded by a Foundation for Evangelism grant, the 2010 Refresh Campus Ministry Conference provided the opportunity for over 200 individuals working in United Methodist campus ministry to be renewed through powerful worship, gain valuable resources through relevant workshops, and network with peers from around the country. This event, held at Church of the Resurrection in Leawood, Kan., equips campus ministry leaders to shepherd young adults through this critical time in their lives, to help students discern God's call on their lives, and to reach out to seekers across the campus.

The Congress on Evangelism

The Foundation for Evangelism was once again pleased to partner with the Council on Evangelism and the General Board of Discipleship for *Refresh*Rebuild*Renew* the 2010 Congress on Evangelism in New Orleans. For the second year, the Foundation provided grant support for the Hispanic-Latino Leaders Scholarship. These funds allowed 17 Hispanic-Latino leaders from across the country to work together on issues specific to evangelism in this underserved population. The Foundation also joined with the Council to provide scholarships to 42 young clergy and spouses to attend their first event. The Congress on Evangelism focuses on developing skills and providing resources for United Methodist clergy and lay leaders in the local church who are passionate about evangelism.

Leadership Development

E. Stanley Jones Professors of Evangelism

The E. Stanley Jones Professors program celebrated two joyous changes in 2010. Dr. Robert Tuttle, Jr. retired after 25 years as E. Stanley Jones Professor of Evangelism at Garrett Evangelical Theological Seminary (1985-2000) and Asbury Theological Seminary, Orlando Campus (2000-2010). When asked what his most rewarding moment as professor has been, Tuttle responded, "I've loved every minute of it!" As a new addition, Drew Dyson, Foundation for Evangelism Timothy Scholar, assumed the E. Stanley Jones Professor of Evangelism Chair at Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington, DC, in August.

Doctoral Education

We celebrate that Jack Jackson, Foundation for Evangelism Denman Fellow, was named evangelism professor at Claremont School of Theology. Additionally, Timothy Scholar Andrew Zirschky was named Academic Director for the Center for Youth Ministry Training at Brentwood UMC (Nashville, TN), and he will teach Youth Ministry at Memphis Theological Seminary. A fellow Timothy Scholar, Jason Santos, will begin serving as Minister to Youth and Families in Seattle, Washington.

Harry Denman Youth Evangelism Award

This award was implemented in 2010 to recognize a young person whose life and ministry exemplifies the teaching of Christ and the Great Commission.

In 2010, The Foundation, in partnership with 42 Annual Conferences, awarded 91 Harry Denman Evangelism Awards to lay and clergy leaders including 15 youth awards.

Culture of the Call Church Award

Swartz Creek United Methodist Church in Swartz Creek, Michigan, was the first church to receive the annual Culture of the Call Award. The award recognizes one local United Methodist congregation with a history of having young people 35 or younger experience God's call to full time Christian service as a result of affiliation with that church.



The Distinguished Evangelist of The United Methodist Church Award

Rev. Shane Bishop of Christ Church in Fairview Heights, Ill., was the recipient of the 2010 Distinguished Evangelist of The United Methodist Church Award. When asked about the guiding principles that Christ Church uses, Rev. Bishop said their main mission is to "move and connect people with Jesus Christ." Dr. Jack Ewing presented the award to Rev. Bishop at Christ Church on November 21.



Vibrant Churches Model Wesleyan Evangelism

Vibrant Churches, a new online resource, has seen a total of 26 churches highlighted in 2010 for their model of Wesleyan Evangelism. These churches have seen a 20% or more growth in attendance over a period of five years and are invited to share their experiences, challenges and successes so that others may be inspired and encouraged to make Wesleyan Evangelism a priority in their ministry.

Dr. John Marshall was named the first emeritus trustee for The Foundation for Evangelism at the annual board meeting held in October. A dinner was held in his honor and he was presented with a small gift and certificate of appreciation from the Foundation trustees.

Our Financial Position

The Foundation for Evangelism continues to recover from the worst financial disaster since the Great Depression as investment returns continue to track closely with budget. Net Assets were up \$254,000 even as more than \$970,000 were released from restriction as planned to meet grant commitments. Total expenses continue to be a focus with a reduction of 21% over 2009. All grant obligations were met.

Efforts remain focused on accountability, stewardship and continued grant support. The Board of Trustees continued an investment strategy focused on sustainability, reducing the impact of the economy on the Foundation's investments and revenues. Operational expenses were closely monitored resulting in a 12% reduction in administrative costs at year's end.

The Foundation for Evangelism continues its focus on providing resources for the development of leaders with a passion for evangelism who will have a multiplying impact on The United Methodist Church.

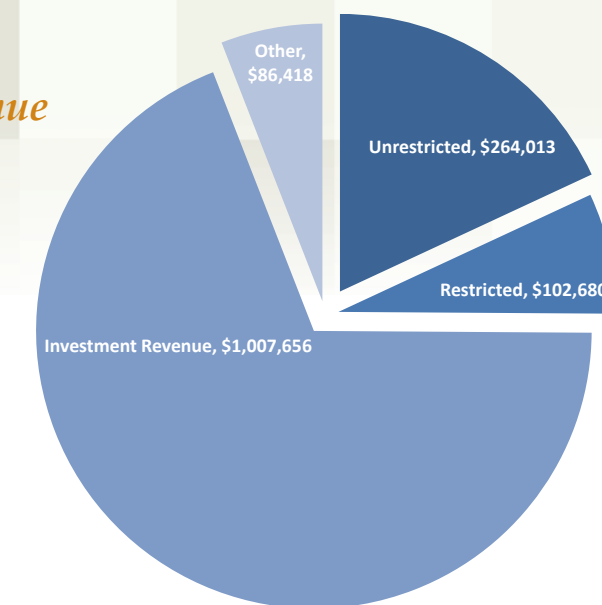

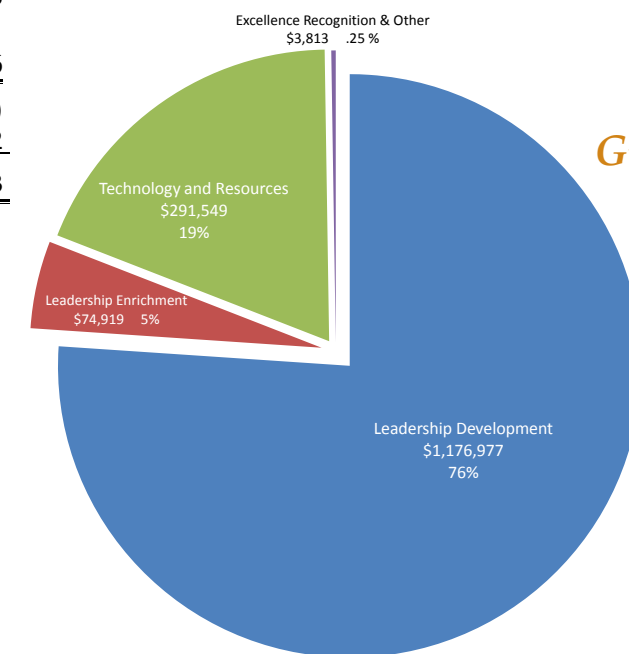
